

## **Merit/ Demerit Policy**

**The merit/ demerit policy is based compliance with the Cadet Handbook. The demerit policy is based on there tiers. Level one is the less severe and level three being the most severe. People receiving the level three demerit will meet the SASI or ASI depending on the severity of the offence. Demotions, expulsion, or restrictions are possible results. Demerits are part of a cadets permanent record.**

**Merits are rewards for positive results. They can cancel out all demerits with the exception of the level three demerit.**

**The merit/ demerit system will be used in the promotion portfolio of all cadets. A level three demerit can cancel a promotion and even cause loss of rank.**

### **MERITS**

- 1. Wear uniform properly every all day on Tuesday.**
- 2. Turn in homework on time.**
- 3. Participate in a activity with GA-956 assigned by the SASI or ASI.**
- 4. Make Fundraiser quota for coke sale.**
- 5. Extra Uniform wear (if worn properly all day)**
- 6. Class achieve over all A on 9 week grade average**
- 7. Recognition for an outstanding action.**
