

SUBJ: Uniform Inspection Accounting

TO: ALL CADETS

1. All cadets are required to wear the Air Force uniform with pride and respect. The proper wear of the uniform is a vital part of the Leadership Education curriculum and grade in ROTC. Cadets are required to wear the uniform on the designated uniform day and wear it for the entire day. Failure to wear the uniform for the entire day will result in a “zero” grade for that day and any other disciplinary actions deemed necessary by the SASI/ASI.
2. If a cadet is absent on the designated wear date, the uniform must be wore on the first the cadet returns to school. If the cadet fails to wear the uniform on the designated date and wears the uniform on the following day, the highest assigned grade will be a passing score of “70”.
3. Each cadet begins the inspection with a grade of “100”. The following points will be subtracted from that grade if uniform violations are discovered:
