

Operating Instructions 10-8

SUBJ: AFJROTC LETTER AWARD POLICY

TO: ALL CADETS

1. To be eligible for an AFJROTC letter, you must be in good academic standing within AFJROTC and the school. Also, a cadet must have an over grade average of 2.0 (“C” average) or better. You must have satisfactorily completed two years or four semesters of the AFJROTC program (at any level) and accumulated a total of 275 points. One semester of the 4 X 4 system equates to one year of academics.
